Computer Based Testing - CBT Advantages:

- Online examination
- Local test centre
- Europe wide
- Paperless administration easier
- Especially suitable for larger numbers



Computer Based Testing - CBT

Requirements:

- Suitable provider
- User friendly software
- Relatively low cost with economies of scale



EBOT Examination

Pre 2010:

- ◆ Exam once yearly 1st W/E October
- Written paper MCQ True or false with negative marking
- Oral exam 5 x 30 minutes next day
- Pass rate around 50%



EBOT Examination

Current:

- Online MCQ taken in June
- Multiple European centres
- 100 questions SBA
- No negative marking
- Must pass part 1 to gain entry to part 2



Results - 2010

Part 1: 50 candidates

- CERTS software optional
- Cost approx 100€ per seat



In training examination

Concept:

- Annual online written MCQ taken in each Training Programme
- Used for practice and as in training assessment
- Ranks trainees by year group
- Can be used to assess programme



In training examination Requirements:

- Locally invigilated, using own PC
- Secure to avoid cheating
- Cheap to run
- Need large question database



Online - low cost - minimal administration

1. Questions are compiled and candidates validated



2. Candidates register and take the exam online



3. Results are processed and reports generated



Exam day




Exam accessed online but runs on windows computer.

Clear presentation and easy navigation of questions during exam.









Administration, results and statistics
