- Statutes unchanged
- Sections represented as advisory members in the Enlarged Executive, an Internal Auditor, Member of Finance Committee
- Advisory Board - Sections voting on policy matters before the Council and negotiations in case of disagreement.
- RoP to be amended in April 2017

Recognition of credits for EU examiners

Scope of recognition:

Examiner in a UEMS exam - examiner taking part in an examination organised by a UEMS Section.

Reviewing process:

Applications must be submitted on the EACCME® website www.eaccme.eu

Material to be submitted through the EACCME® website:

Application form with:

- Name of the examination
- Date of the examination
- Venue of the examination
- Name of the examiner

Fee: Free of charge

Allocation of credits: 2 credits per examination
