Torino 2010 EBSQ GenSurg

- Honorary diploma for the faculty of the <u>examination board</u>
- The GenSurg Examination was performed in an OSCE-Circuit with 6 stations to each 10 minutes.
- The candidates were briefed and anonymized by the chairman. They drew numbers for the <u>starting grid</u> and received 6 stickers for the evaluation forms.
- All documents were prepared and printed out. The evaluation forms with the candidates' stickers and the actual scoring were collected online after being signed by the 2 examiners from each station. The scoring was entered online by the chairman and the result calculated.
- 75 points could be reached in every station, the maximum being 450 points. The threshold for passing was defined with 75%.
- The 11 candidates came from/had their education in the following 7 countries: Australia, Austria (2), Emirates/Dubai, Dubai/Germany, Pakistan/Ireland, Poland, Syria, Turkey, Egypt/UK, Malta/UK were eligibile for the exam.
- <u>o candidates</u> passed the examination. Candidates #7 and #9 failed.

Torino 2010 EBSQ GenSurg

- After the examination the candidates were asked to fill out a feedback form (enclosed).
- The evaluation of the feedback questionnaires is laid down separately (enclosed).
- The certificates with the "Fellowship of the European Board of Surgery" were handed out in a short celebration immediately after the debriefing of the examination board

Evaluation of candidates' responses – Essentially:

- More time generally for the examination
- More time specifically for Station 6
- A clinical station
- More privacy and less noise
- Exam setting near an air communication hub
- Location more easy to find

What we learnt:

- Improve pre-exam instructions for candidates
- Stricter checks on identity documentation
- Formal acceptance by candidate of anonimisation code
- Pre-exam instruction video for examiners
- More formalized Quality Assurance and Quality Improvement procedures
- Less disturbance between stations
- Improvement of the exam format
- Unsuccessful candidates should not be confronted personally but by post or e-mail
- Formal Review and Appeals procedure with time constraints should be in place.

- Alteration in the stations to include simulation and critical appraisal of a research paper.
- Preparatory courses to be organized by the Faculty

EBSQ GenSurg Salzburg 2012

- 100 MC questions & 6 OSCE circuit stations
- content is identical for the national Austrian and UEMS exam
- UEMS exam is officially accepted as Austrian final exam for specialization in GenSurg (=automatic mutual recognition in the EU)
- by that UEMS GenSurg exam is for the first time officially accepted in the EU
- steps to legalization of the EBSQ i.e:
- National recognition of EBSQ as an Exit Exam
- National Exit Exam to be dropped in favour of the EBSQ
- ? Convergence with the extended Bologna Process
