Please list events/topics/developments that you consider the most important for medical specialists in your country	<p>Finland had been planning a major social and health care reform for a long time, and the Parliament finally endorsed the laws in June 2021. A key feature of the reform is the integration of primary and hospital care, as well as that of health and social services. The responsibility for organizing services moved from over 300 municipalities to 21 regions and the City of Helsinki as of 1 January 2023. The regions receive their funding from the national government, and many of them are now facing severe financial difficulties. Regional elections in these “wellbeing services counties” were held in April 2025 for the second time. A general trend to centralize HC service provision towards bigger units to cut costs is obvious.</p> <p>The FMA has long emphasized that a key priority should be to strengthen the primary health care and guarantee adequate continuity of care. A well-working primary health care is also the basis for functional specialized care. Other FMA goals are e.g. to increase the level of health care funding and guarantee sufficient resources for medical education, including CME/CPD, and research.</p> <p>The Finnish Government has increased the number of new medical students over the past years and, furthermore, an increasing number of young Finns study medicine in e.g. the Baltic countries, Romania, and Sweden, with the aim to return to Finland after graduation. The FMA has invited all relevant</p>



	<p>bodies for an analytical discussion towards a national consensus regarding the realistic number of medical workforce expected to be needed in the future. The quality of education must be guaranteed in all circumstances, which requires adequate resources for education and training.</p> <p>Recent prognoses regarding future specialist workforce indicate that in many specialties there is an urgent need to increase specialist training (e.g. psychiatry, diagnostic specialties), whereas in some others, trainee numbers should be even decreased. A new selection procedure to specialist training was introduced in 2019, with the aim to gradually balance future demand and supply of specialists. National prognosis on future specialist training needs are updated annually.</p> <p>There is also concern about equal distribution of specialists in different parts of the country. There can be a shortage of specialists in certain parts of the country and, at the same time, oversupply in other parts, especially in the bigger cities.</p> <p>The specialist training in Finland is being developed towards competence-based structures, the five medical faculties collaborating here actively. The new model requires considerable resources from the senior specialists acting as supervisors/tutors/mentors, which has to be taken into account in the resource allocation at health care units. However, the national government has decided to reduce the 2026-2027 compensation for specialist training for health care units due to savings in the national budget.</p> <p>The Finnish Government is also planning a revision of the law on health care professionals. However, it is unlikely that e.g. recertification would be introduced in Finland in the near future.</p>

Core elements: introduction of provision-based payments (Vorhaltevergütung) instead of financing solely via DRGs. Hospitals are compensated for maintaining services, even if not constantly utilized.</p> <p>Establishment of a transformation fund to support restructuring of the hospital landscape.</p> <p>Greater emphasis on quality and specialization: a committee for service groups (“Leistungsgruppen”) issues recommendations for how hospital services should be regulated and allocated.</p> <p>Germany is working on further digitalization: New Digital Act (DigiG) accelerates the roll-out of mandatory digital services. Since January 15, 2025, the electronic health record (ePA) is automatically set up for all statutory health insurance members (opt-out solution).</p>

<p>Please list events/topics/developments that you consider the most important for medical specialists in your country</p>	<p>Currently, two legal issues are attracting attention in Tunisia, where a reform of the laws governing the practice of medicine is on the agenda.</p> <p>1- The recently passed law on patients' rights and medical liability, which is raising many concerns even before it has begun to be implemented.</p> <p>2- A bill concerning the health professions, with particular attention being paid to attacks against health professionals.</p> <p>Another aspect concerns the practice of specialist doctors: the list of qualifications that can be awarded by the Medical Council is exhaustive and does not cover many subspecialties or highly specialised super-specialties, making their legal status very uncertain in the event of a problem involving a doctor's responsibility.</p>
