We develop **European Training Requirements** in **over 70 medical specialties or disciplines**, setting out the knowledge, skills, and attitudes that a specialist must acquire during their training in order to practice independently and safely.



We organise **European examinations** in more than 40 medical fields, to assure high-level standards of the training of medical specialists.



We assess and accredit training centres to ensure high standards training with optimal environment for trainees and trainers.

Continuing Medical Education

The UEMS – EACCME® — European Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education — accredits more than 3,000 medical education activities across Europe.

Our rigorous accreditation process and criteria are designed to promote excellence in CME and CPD,

ensuring the highest quality and most up-to-date patient care.

Moreover, the UEMS – EACCME® supports the international recognition of CME credits, enabling their acceptance not only across Europe but also in the USA, Canada, Latin America, and the Caribbean.

Advocacy

UEMS engages in dialogue with EU institutions and health stakeholders to ensure that the voice of medical specialists is heard in policy making.

We take part in European projects to improve medical practice and the working conditions and professional environment of doctors.








About us
